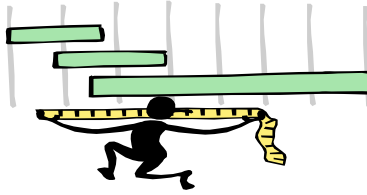


How do your words measure up??
