

Baptized and Overwhelmed

I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance. but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

Whose fan is in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

Strong's gives the word a few different uses-

1. To dip repeatedly, to immerse, to submerge
2. To cleanse by dipping or submerging, to wash, to make clean with water, to wash one's self, bathe
3. To overwhelm

And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me. For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.

Acts 1:4-5

Strong's gives the word a few different uses-

1. Teach others to follow the commands of Christ.
2. Baptize them- (immerse them) in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost- the phrase “in the name” means with the authorization- the blessing of- the approval of- each member of the Godhead- says this soul belongs to me.
