## **Matthew 21:12**

"And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves."

- B. Deacons are men chosen from the assembly.

- E. Deacons give particular attention to the physical and material aspects of the ministry.
- F. Deacons must be sensitive to the needs of the people.

- G. Deacons must be sensitive to inequity, disgruntlement, interpersonal tensions, etc.
- H. Deacons appropriately serve God and the church in many other ways, as well.
