Poetic Device—Synonymous

The two poetic lines parallel.

Poetic Device—Synonymous

A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels: Prov 1:5

Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: Mat 7:7

Poetic Device—Antithetical

The two poetic lines contrast.

Poetic Device—Antithetical

A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother. Proverbs 10:1

The wicked flee when no man pursueth: but the righteous are bold as a lion. Prov 28:1

Poetic Device—Synthetic

The second line unpacks the first.

Poetic Device—Synthetic

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. Ps 23:1

Who can find a virtuous woman? for her price is far above rubies. Prov 31:10
