2. Jesus is the Bread of Life.

3. Eating the bread is a metaphor for believing on Jesus.

Mark 14:23-24 "And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them: and they all drank of it. 24 And he said unto them, This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many."
